# EVALUATION OF DIRECT ENHANCEMENT SERVICES

## Evaluation of Direct Enhancement Services

### COMPREHENSIVE CONSUMER EDUCATION

Describe how the Coalition developed, established, expanded, operated, and coordinated resource and referral programs specifically related to the provision of comprehensive consumer education to parents and the public to promote informed child care choices.

Our Child Care Resource and Referral (CCRR) program connects parents with the child care programs and community resources best suited to meet the family's needs. CCRR is a free service. Parents can either go online, come in, or call the local offices and speak with a CCRR specialist to discuss the family's child care options and needs.

The ELC also participates in the Help Me Grow Program in Putnam and St Johns counties which promotes early identification of developmental, behavioral, or educational concerns, then links children and families to community-based services and supports at no cost to parents and caregivers.

To get the word out in our communities about our CCRR services, staff attend community events to distribute Resource and Referral literature and answer questions about our services. During the 2023-2024 program year, staff participated in numerous community meetings and events where over 2500 outreach materials were distributed to promote Child Care Resource and Referral. In addition, staff served on community committees such as the Community Alliance of Northeast Florida, Clay SafetyNet Alliance, Keystone SafetyNet Alliance, and the St. Johns Head Start Policy Council.

CCRR provides other important information and referrals to parents. CCRR Specialists inform parents about quality indicators in the child care setting so that parents can make an informed choice. Every parent receives a parent packet that includes a quality indicator checklist to be used as parents visit potential programs. CCRR staff provide referrals to Child Find and other community services. To be accessible to our clients, we have offices located in each county with walk-in hours and appointments and are accessible by phone, email, and through our online scheduling system.

**CDA courses-** Qualifying Criteria: CDA Application. Participants are required to apply and recipients' progress through the course is monitored by the CDA specialist on staff. Monitoring: CDA specialist monitors the course progress of participants.

**Teaching Strategies Gold Implementation-** Qualifying Criteria: SR providers were required to apply for a program to achieve child assessment reliability. Participating providers received free access to child files in TSG. Monitoring: Child Assessment Reliability certificates.

**FCCHA Conference-** Qualifying Criteria: FCCH providers were required to apply for the scholarship which awarded a scholarship to use on conference registration and/or hotel stay. Monitoring: Providers were required to submit conference agenda/certificate, and a write up of what they learned at the conference.

**MMCI/CLASS Group Coaching-** Qualifying Criteria: Participants were required to apply to attend training at no cost to the participant. Monitoring: Progress through the course cohort is tracked by the Course Instructor.

## TRAINING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Provide a list and description of trainings and/or technical assistance activities the coalition offered to school readiness program providers, staff, and parents in each of the following areas.

- **Early Learning Standards**

A cross walk between CLASS and Early Learning Standards is used to inform providers of the connection of both tools through TA and coaching using the crosswalk.

- **Child Screenings**

Ongoing TA is given to providers who need assistance with completing child screening and assessments and is given on an as-needed basis. Some training courses offered cover this topic as well. Instructions and TA are ongoing with providers with the use of screening features in EFSM.

- **Child Assessments**

TA is offered on an as needed basis for providers completing child assessments. Training is available within the Child Assessment tool of provider choice and TA is given to providers on how to access such training.

- **Child Development Research and Best Practices**

Coaching, training and TA are given in these areas to inform providers of best practices in offering high quality child care to families. Research is shared on child development within these coaching, training, and TA sessions based on the are being addressed.

- **Developmentally Appropriate Curricula and Character Development**

Technical assistance is given on an as-needed basis for curriculum and character development needs. Some training courses offered cover this topic as well.

- **Teacher-Child Interactions**

Teacher Child Interactions are the primary focus of our coaching program with providers/teachers. Multiple training courses cover this area as well. MyTeachstone accounts are offered to providers to provide even more access to Teacher-Child Interaction strategies and best practices.

- **Age-Appropriate Discipline Practices**

Training courses conducted address age-appropriate discipline practices and much of the TA given by inclusion specialists also cover this topic.

- **Health and Safety**

Multiple training courses provided over the year included Health and Safety best practices. If coaches or staff notice a serious lack in the health and safety of a child care program, TA is given immediately.

- **Nutrition**

TA is offered on an as needed basis.

- **First Aid**

TA is offered on an as needed basis and can be incorporated into existing Health and Safety training courses and TA.

- **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation**

This is offered through other community partners in our area.

- **Recognition of Communicable Diseases**

TA is offered on an as needed basis and can be incorporated into existing Health and Safety training and TA. Information about procedures and precautions regarding Health & Safety are shared with providers throughout the year as needed.

- **Child Abuse Detection, Prevention and Reporting**

We offer TA as needed on this topic as well as forwarding information on this topic to providers.

## QUALITY ACTIVITIES FOR INFANT AND TODDLER CARE

Provide a description of the quality activities and services the coalition provided to enhance infant and toddler care.

We have an education team member on the State Infant/Toddler Network group to stay updated on any IT developments and share info as appropriate with teammates and providers. We offer Trainings for Infant/Toddler teachers on a wide variety of topics. Coaching and TA are also given for I/T teachers to help incorporate appropriate practices and strategies into the classroom and increase the quality of Infant/Toddler child/teacher interactions.

# EVALUATION OF DIRECT ENHANCEMENT SERVICES

## MONITORING

Describe the process for monitoring compliance with, and enforcement of, applicable state and local requirements.

The ECS Director of Quality Assurance and Data Integrity along with the Quality Assurance Coordinator are responsible for ensuring for monitoring of compliance with, and enforcement of, applicable state and local requirements. All Plan Outcomes are monitored through interviews, documentation of activities, and proper back-up documentation at least annually as are contract requirements. Internal procedures and policies describe the processes and results of quarterly monitoring by the ELC prove our methods to be effective. Processes are reviewed regularly for updates and results of all monitoring are communicated immediately to the Chief of Programs.

ECS develops a monitoring plan to monitor School Readiness and VPK programs. The ELC reviews and approves the plan annually. The plan uses DEL sample sizes and protocols to ensure that each participating provider is adhering to contractual requirements and adherence to child attendance and reimbursement using the approved DEL monitoring tools and complying with DEL mandated sample sizes.

The ELC monitors its subrecipient, ECS, on a quarterly basis using DEL monitoring tools whenever possible. Key areas monitored are: Fiscal review of non-direct costs (SR and VPK), Fiscal overview to include review of internal controls and cost allocation plan; VPK and SR enrollment files, attendance review and payment validation for VPK and SR. VPK and SR provider requirements and SR provider services (provider contract and education files).

From each monitoring the ELC addresses any findings, concerns or observations that are discovered. The subrecipient has the opportunity to respond to a draft report to clarify any questions and then a final report is created. Corrective action plans (if applicable) will be provided to the ELC. The ELC then provides an acceptance/rejection letter with terms and timelines (if applicable). The contractor typically has about a month to submit any corrective action items and submit to the ELC. If satisfied, a monitoring close-out letter is issued to the contractor.

## INCLUSION

Describe the activities the coalition has implemented to promote inclusive child care, including responding to Warm-Line requests by providers and parents, and providing developmental and health screenings to school readiness program children.

Warm-line requests are handled by our Inclusion Specialists who respond in a timely manner to parents and providers' requests and concerns. Inclusion Specialists promote inclusive childcare by providing training on a variety of topics, including teacher-child interactions and trauma informed care. SR children receive ASQ screenings routinely, including ASQ SE, if the parent/guardian agrees to screening. Onsite classroom/child observations are also offered for all childcare providers requesting it, as well as follow-

up plans for the teachers and parents to increase the ability of the provider/teacher to offer individualized Services as needed.
